

# IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF TEACHING IN TIMES OF A GLOBAL PANDEMIC



## USAID Youth Ethnic Integration Project Key Accomplishments:

Over 1,400 school representatives (teachers, student support staff and school management) participated in nine capacity building activities aimed to contribute to improved quality of teaching, especially through digital means.

Over 12,000 students participated in around 1,000 online activities (100 online activities that lead to the implementation of Youth Actions, 757 online joint curricular classes, around 80 online extracurricular activities and over 90 online youth initiatives) from more than 200 primary and secondary schools.

Five guidelines related to assessment tools for Civic Education teachers, online teaching methods and tools, online extracurricular activities and online subject clubs were developed.



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
